Safe Ride Home is a free, confidential service in which clients are driven home in their own vehicle by a team of volunteers.

We're putting together volunteer teams for the 2019 Safe Ride Home Sudbury Campaign. Come on out and enjoy a fun filled evening of community service!

What Does A Safe Ride Home Team Do?

You could be part of a three-member team that picks up clients who call the service for a ride. The team drives to the pick-up location in an escort car. One team member (Designated Driver), accompanied by a second team member (Navigator) for safety reasons, drives the client and any passengers to the destination of their choice, in the client's car. The third team member (Escort Driver) follows in the escort car and, at the end of the trip, takes the whole team on to the next call. Teams communicate with headquarters via supplied two-way radios.

Each team will consist of:

- Escort Driver (Driver's Licence required, Minimum age requirement is 19 years)
- Designated Driver (Driver's Licence required, Minimum age requirement is 21 years)
- Navigator (Driver's Licence NOT required, Minimum age requirement is 19 years)

The evening begins by:

- Volunteers meet at the headquarters, NORCAT, 1545 Maley Drive, at 7:30 p.m.
- A brief orientation session will begin after sign in.
- Volunteers will receive free coffee compliments of Tim Hortons for the duration of their evening
- Sandwiches and desserts are provided by Your Independent Grocers

The evening ends by:

 Volunteers return to our headquarters where pizza is provided by Toppers Pizza
